

The clerk explained that as the meeting was being held in the purdah period before an election that Standing Order 3e would be strictly enforced; public and councillors could only discuss the two items on the agenda.

A statement was read by the Chair providing the background to the agenda items.

1. Apologies Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr Hancox and Cllr Hardy.

2. Declarations of Interest and Dispensations
Cllr Viviani declared that she lived on Blenheim Way.

3. Public Participation
Residents were concerned about the implications of the proposal by GWR and a private landowner to to develop a carpark on the land adjacent to Blenheim Meadow

4. Transfer of land from Crest Nicholson

RESOLVED To approve the acquisition of Blenheim Meadow, currently on a 250 year lease, with no restrictive covenants but subject to rights to public utility services by signing the Transfer Deed. Costs £1 plus legal fees estimated at £1200. Voting: 9 in favour.

5. Access
Cllr K Herbert and Cllr Fawcett proposed amendments to the original proposal which read:
Proposed: To grant access to GWR and the adjacent landowner over Blenheim Meadow for the development of a carpark on their land solely for the purpose of survey and feasibility work.

RESOLVED To grant access to GWR and the adjacent landowner over Blenheim Meadow to assess the feasibility of a carpark on their land using conventional surveying equipment only. Voting 8 in favour, 1 against.
