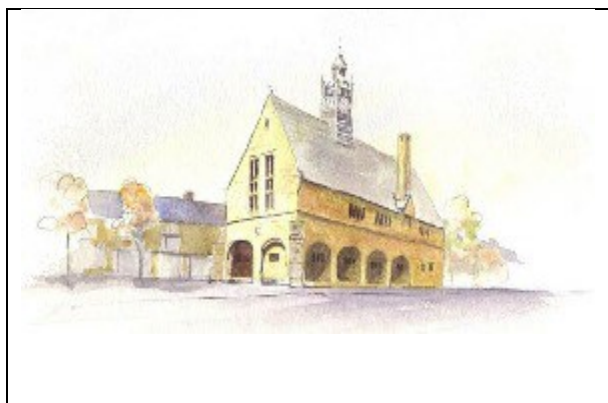

Does the draft NPPS adequately address Cotswolds National Landscape considerations (e.g. the Board's statutory purposes, outlined at Section 4.0 of the NPPS and its duty to foster the economic and social well-being of people living in the National Landscape)? Yes ii. Does the draft NPPS help with ensuring that neighbourhood planning groups can adequately address Cotswolds National Landscape considerations? Yes – but it would be good to have an executive summary to steer people towards relevant sections of the document. iii. Does the draft NPPS fulfil the purposes of the Board's Position Statements outlined at Section 2.0? Yes iv. Does the draft NPPS add value to other guidance that is already available, either from your local authority or other organisations? Yes v. Do you have any further comments on the draft NPPS? To reiterate the point made above – it would be really valuable to have an executive summary for those

	responsible for NDP's to point them in the right direction. The Town Council would like to see the outcome of the consultation.
