The report from Plan-et just before the Open day on the 21st is that we had 155 online responses. At the same time there were 39 responses in the Town Council collection box so if the other two boxes are similar then half way through the survey we might have received about 275 responses. Plan-et said that most of the online responses were "strongly agree" or "agree". • the Open Day was a big success and we had a steady stream of people coming to the NDP stand and had a lot of, mostly, positive discussions. • from the Open Day we had 3 people who showed an interest in joining the working group. Malcolm, Nick and I are meeting them tomorrow evening for an informal chat. • we've received the latest invoice from Plan-et and Teresa should have a copy of that. I've not yet had a discussion about the NDP budget with the Town Council, so we should put some time in the diary to do that so that I know what our budget is and can then track against it. |
